PRAISE: A mission team from St. Louis-Faith Lutheran M.S. along with Lakota men and HFM staff, completed the residing of Pine Ridge Gospel Fellowship Church, in October. The new brown steel roof was completed last year and we thank the Lord that the same faithful men returned to reside the church, as well. We are so grateful to all who help and support HFM's on going commitment to help encourage and support local churches on the Pine Ridge reservation!

BLESSING: A three ton mini-split (AC and Heat) was also installed in the HFM Warrior Center. This heat pump will help in reducing the heating and cooling costs in the Great Room. Also, a campus Wifi system with fiber optic connection was installed, giving 5G access to the entire HFM facility. This will save \$150/month in costs. This was also another gift provided by Faith Lutheran of St. Louis.





PRAISE: The Warrior Center is primarily heated by a wood boiler outside the building, which helps keep heating costs to a minimum. This then requires labor to be invested in cutting and splitting the wood to be available in the cold seasons. Dan Leicht, his son Josiah and Dalton Carpenter (HFM intern) have been working faithfully to have a ready supply of wood available for the center's heating needs, of which we are grateful!

BLESSING: Joshua "Dalton" Carpenter has been serving as an intern the last five months at Hands of Faith. He has been doing street ministry outreach on the Pine Ridge reservation involving feeding the homeless and sharing the Good News of the Gospel. He has also helped with mission projects, dorm supervision, Will Graham outreach on Pine Ridge, and lending support and providing hands on encouragement.
